1. What is the Minimum Passing Score (MPS)?

CFA does not disclose the exact algorithm they use to determine the MPS (minimum passing score), but no Candidate scoring over 70% overall on a CFA exam has ever failed in the past. Pass rate for Level 1/ 2/ 3 in the past is around 43%/ 45% / 56%

Do you automatically fail if you fail 'Ethics' section?

There is no concept of pass or fail in individual subjects. There is however an "Ethics Adjustment" given CFA's emphasis on ethics - if a candidate is boardline pass/fail, then his/her performance in the Ethics session can positively/ negatively impact the Candidate's final result (usually positively)

3. Are there any spare pencil/ rubber/ sharpener/ calculator at the exam center?

Even if there is, no equipment would be given to the Candidate on Exam day - do remember to bring spare pencils/ rubbers/ pencil sharpeners/calculators
